

FUTMINNA TO ESTABLISH TECHNOLOGICAL INNOVATION PARK AS RESEARCHERS, INVENTORS GET AWARDS

The Vice-Chancellor, Federal University of Technology, Minna, Prof. Faruk Adamu Kuta has expressed his management's willingness to establish a Technological Innovation Park (TIP) where products generated from research activities shall be showcased, with a view to preserving them and stimulating the interest of younger generations towards research and innovation for national development.

He stated this while making remarks at the 2023 Researchers and Inventors Award Ceremony organized by the University's

Directorate of Research, Innovation and Development (DRID) on Monday, September 25, 2023 at the Justice Idris Legbo Kutigi Mini Hall, Minna.

Prof. Kuta who reiterated that teaching, research and community service are the three cardinal responsibilities which a university is known for, also stressed the need for researchers to always venture into publications that will boost the University's ranking in the global arena, adding that, universities are rated by the quality of their research outputs.

Prof Kuta made this known when the officials of ITF Area Office, Minna in company of the SIWES directors and coordinators of tertiary institutions in Niger State paid him a courtesy visit on Thursday, September 27, 2023 at the Senate Chamber, Main Campus, Gidan Kwano.

Represented by the Director, Academic Planning Unit, Prof. Abdullahi Mohammed, the Vice-Chancellor disclosed that the Nigeria University System is undergoing robust curriculum development and that the National Universities Commission has directed all Nigerian Universities to, by the beginning of next academic session, work with the new curriculum tagged "Core Curriculum and Minimum Academic Standard (CCMAS)."

Speaking further on CCMAS, Prof Kuta said that the curriculum emphasizes on skill acquisition rather than just the theoretical aspect.

Speaking earlier, the Director-General, Industrial Training Fun (ITF) Mr. Joe Ari,

represented by the ITF, Area Manager, Engr. Aliyu I. Zakari appreciated the Management of FUT, Minna for accepting to host this year's SIWES 3rd Quarter Zonal Meeting.

The Area Manager further stated that in modern workplaces, success does not depend on the class of degree an individual has but on what skill one brings to the table. He expressed optimism that the deliberation at the meeting will go a long way to provide solution to the challenges often encountered by all SIWES stakeholders, which will serve as a catalyst for stimulating a favourable environment for academic pursuit.

The Vice-Chancellor, Federal University of Technology, Minna, Prof. Faruk Adamu Kuta, has assured officials of the Nigerian Institute of Physics (NIP) of the management team of the University's commitment to the continuous survival of the Institute.

He gave the assurance on Tuesday, September 26, 2023, while responding to requests by the officials who paid him a courtesy visit at the Main Campus, Gidan Kwano.

On the request for a proposed state chapter secretariat of NIP within the University, Prof. Kuta promised to work with the Academic Planning Unit and other relevant units to see to its realization.

"I want to say that at a very short notice, we will respond to your request. We will have a small place so that we can start from somewhere. Let that place be the coordinating unit. We will do that and I assure you, we will get back to you as soon as possible," he further said.

Prof. Kuta expressed confidence in members of the Institute who are also members of staff of the University. He also appealed that special attention be accorded to the chapter, adding that, with the calibre of personalities in the

chapter, the Institute would achieve its objectives.

Speaking earlier, the President of the Institute, Prof. J. O. Coker, FNIP, COMEG, (Rgd), said, as part of efforts to ensure grassroots mobilization of all physicists, the Council of NIP embarked on a tour across all states of the federation in order to inaugurate chapters, hence its visit to Niger State.

"The chapter is to bring all physicists in Niger State from different higher institutions, agencies as well as secondary schools in synergy so that they would collaborate and make good impact in the state. There must be a change in narrative on performance in physics. We must ensure capacity building programmes for the teachers," the don emphasized.

While expressing his appreciation to the Vice-Chancellor for the hospitality extended to him and members of his team, Prof. Coker recalled the support the Institute got in 2017 when FUT, Minna hosted the NIP Conference.

He added that NIP Council had resolved that the University is the best and most suitable place for the state chapter secretariat.

In a bid to revolutionize curriculum delivery and efficiently manage large classes, the Vice-Chancellor

of the Federal University of Technology, Minna, Prof. Faruk Adamu Kuta, has called on specialised Universities of Technology to spearhead the adoption of technology in education.

The call was made during the inaugural session of a two-day training for e-course lecturers, held on 25th September, 2023, at the Senate Chamber, Main Campus, Gidan Kwano.

Prof. Kuta, represented by the Director of Academic Planning and Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic) designate, Prof. Abdullahi Muhammed highlighted that nearly 95% of students are enrolled in public Universities, resulting in large class sizes. He emphasized the potential of e-platforms in effectively managing such extensive classes.

He commended the progress made by FUT, Minna, in utilizing e-platforms for teaching, administration of e-tests, and examinations.

Reflecting on the challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic, Prof. Kuta noted that the African Sub-Region faced disruptions in education due to the traditional teaching methods. He stressed the importance of experts guiding educators in

embracing student-centred methodologies through e-teaching and e-learning.

The Vice-Chancellor expressed gratitude to the organisers for their efforts in ensuring the success of the training and reiterated the commitment of FUT, Minna, to deliver efficient services to its students in large-population classes.

Speaking earlier in his welcome address, the SERVICOM Focal Officer and Chairman of the E-Teaching Committee, Prof. Adamu Yusuf Kabiru, highlighted the objective of the training to empower those responsible for implementing the University's e-teaching policy. He emphasized the need for rigorous screening and affirmation of uploaded course materials to maintain quality.

The training session featured experts from various departments, units, and centres of the University, covering essential topics such as Course ware Development, delivered by Prof. Isiaka A. Gambari; Video Lecture Production, by Prof. Abdullahi I. Enagi; Use of Learning Management Systems (LMS), by Mr. Ezra Kolo; Virtual Classroom Production, by Engr. Raphael Agboola; and Complaint and Redress Mechanisms, by Mrs. Funke Adeoye

In pursuit of the Federal University of Technology, Minna core objectives revolving around research and innovation for societal development, the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Faruk Adamu Kuta, aspires to elevate the institution's global recognition and influence through ground-breaking research initiatives.

This vision was made known during a workshop organised by the Department of Mathematics. The workshop, on Control Strategies for COVID-19 Transmission Pandemic, was held on Thursday, 28th September, 2023, both in a physical setting at the Department's Main Lecture Hall, Main Campus, Gidan Kwano, and in a virtual domain.

Represented by the Deputy Director, Directorate of Research, Innovation and Development (DRID), Prof. Ocheme Boniface Ocheme, the Vice-Chancellor emphasised this strategic goal, underlining the commitment to position the University prominently on the global academic landscape.

According to him, there was a recent occasion where researchers who published in esteemed journals, recipients of the TETFund grant twice, patent holders, and those who have notably served the University were recognised. The individuals behind this initiative emphasized its continuation to inspire researchers to persist in their hard work, he added.

Prof. Kuta expressed appreciation for the outstanding performance of the department as well as the research team, particularly acknowledging their success in securing research grants, notably in the National Research Fund (NRF).

"All those who have contributed have consistently upheld the University's expectations, and for that, we commend them," he stated.

Earlier in his opening remark, the Dean, School of Physical Sciences (SPS), Prof. Mohammed Jiya mentioned the significance of Mathematics as the universal language utilised to solve real-life problems. He urged young students to dispel the misconception that Mathematics is a difficult subject and hoped they would gain a deeper understanding of its applications, especially in combatting the COVID-19 pandemic.

Presenting his address, the Head of Department (HOD), Mathematics, Prof. Abdullahi Enagi highlighted the department's pivotal role, as all enrolled students at the University must pass through it. He emphasised the reputation of Mathematicians as critical thinkers known for providing solutions to emerging challenges both within and outside the academic realm.

Prof. Enagi also recounted significant initiatives of the department, including the development and adoption of Examination Processing Software and the initiation of the PGC, being adopted by the University.

"When all students were in lockdown, those in the Mathematics Department took lectures wherever they were," he said.

Also speaking during the main presentation, the Principal Researcher and Chief Convener of the research team, Prof. Ninuola I. Akinwade disclosed their proactive response to the COVID-19 pandemic while the country was under lockdown. Their Research Group won the National Research Grant of the TETFund for the year 2020 with which they conducted the research, which involved a collaborative effort across four Universities: FUT Minna, Benue State University (BSU) Makurdi, Federal University, Birnin Kebbi, and Joseph Sarwuan Tarka University, Makurdi (formerly named Federal University of Agriculture, Makurdi).

"The aim of this workshop is to present our modest contribution to the quest by health authorities and all concerned stakeholders in exploring all forms of possibilities for the control and possible eradication of COVID-19 pandemic, with Nigeria as a case study," he revealed.

The don said, according to WHO 2021 report, the disease, caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus-2 (SARS-CoV-2), spread rapidly over 210 countries across Europe, Asia, sub-Saharan Africa and America, with the utmost prevalence in America.

Prof. Akinwade warned that the COVID-19 is still prevalent in society because the NCDC and WHO, reports revealed that as of 27th August 2023, COVID-19 resulted in over 770 million confirmed cases and over 6.9 million deaths globally. In Nigeria as at 25th September, 2023, the total confirmed cases was 265,105, recovery cases were 257,594, active cases was 4,356 and total deaths was 3,151.

Further presentations and recommendations were by Dr. Samuel Abu Somma and Mrs. Abdurahman Nurat who recommended that constant and continuous disinfection or fumigation of surfaces and dead bodies before burial is found to be one of the most effective strategy in curbing the spread of the disease. Again, open defecation should be discouraged in order to reduce the population of COVID-19 pathogens in the environment.

Various dignitaries, including the Dean of Post-graduate School, Prof. Oladiran Kamardeen Abubakre, the Director, DRID represented by the Deputy Director, Prof. Ocheme, the HOD, Department of Microbiology, Prof. Nasiru Usman Adabara gave their goodwill messages while commending the trail-blazing effort of the researchers.

In his vote of thanks the Chairman of the Academic Staff Union of Universities, FUT, Minna Branch, and staff of the department, Prof. Gbolahan Bolarin extended gratitude on behalf of the department, recognising and appreciating the collaborative efforts and remarkable achievements of the research team.
