DR. REUBEN KOLO IS NOW LATEST PROF

The Professorial cadre of the Federal University of Technology, Minna has received a new entrant. He is Prof. Reuben Jiya Kolo of the Department of Water Resources Aquaculture and Fisheries Technology, (WAFT).

Council approved his promotion at its 91st meeting held on Friday, May 11, 2012.

Prof. Kolo who joined the University as an Assistant Lecturer on July 7, 1990 was born on March 2, 1962, at Doko, Lavun Local Government area of Niger State and had his primary education in Doko between 1970 and 1976. From 1976 to 1980, he was at Government Secondary School, Kuta where he proceeded to Government Science College, Kagara for the completion of his secondary education in 1981.

He graduated with a B. Sc. Hons. Degree in Biology from the Ahmadu Bello University, Zaria in 1987. Between 1988 and 1990, he was at the University of Ibadan where he bagged an M.Sc. (Hydrobiology and Fisheries).

In 1993, he enrolled for a Doctor of Philosophy Degree at Federal University of Technology, Minna which he successfully completed in 1996 with specialization in Water Quality Management.

Prof. Kolo who is currently the Deputy Dean, Postgraduate School was at different times the Head of Department, WAFT among several other positions he held in the University.

The promotion is with effect from October 1, 2010.

Meanwhile, Council at the same meeting, approved the promotion of the following to the rank of Associate Professor with effect from October 1, 2010: Dr. Nassir Bello, Department of Library Information Technology; Dr. Idah Aba, Department of Agricultural and Bioresources Engineering as well as Dr. Elizabeth Onwuka, Department of Telecommunication Engineering.
