### **FUT, MINNA TO TRAIN WELDERS**

The Federal University of Technology, Minna has won a contract to provide training services to the Petroleum Technology Development Fund (PTDF) for the training of welders under the PTDF Welders Training and Certification Programme (WTCP) 2012.

This was made known by the Director FUTMIN Ventures Ltd, Dr. A. S. Ma'aji in a chat with Campus News. According to him the training which covers module 'A' (Fillet Weld), is for the period of three (3) months and will commence on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> February, 2012. He also called on PTDF to extend the partnership built over the years to other areas beyond the welders programme.
