FUT, MINNA PARTNERS KKONTECH FOR INTERNET SERVICE DELIVERY

In order to boost internet speed that would enhance learning and research, Federal University of Technology, Minna has signed a broadband internet service level agreement with **KKON Technologies Limited**.

The agreement was signed on Tuesday, August 6, 2013 at the Vice-Chancellor's Conference Room, Main Campus.

In his remark, the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Musbau Adewumi Akanji, *FNSBMB*, said the agreement is very important to the University in view of its commitment to Information and Communication Technology (ICT) and desire to enhance the institution's webo-metric ranking.

Prof. Akanji assured the Company that FUT, Minna would work hard to fulfil the contractual obligation and be faithful to the tenets of the agreement.

Speaking earlier, the Managing Director of the KKONTech, Mr. Lanre Ore thanked the University Management for finding the company worthy of the partnership and assured them of the company's commitment to high speed internet service delivery and service uptime.

Mr. Lanre further noted that the University would benefit a lot from the Company's ten years experience in ICT related matters and promised to ensure that the partnership grows.

KKON Technologies Limited would provide 45 Mega Bytes Per Second (Mbps) upload/45 Mbps download and Committed Information Rate (CIP) uninterrupted internet connectivity.
