Jinadu and Dr. (Mrs) Zinash Delebo Osunde from Associate Professors to the rank of Professors of Urban and Regional Planning and Agricultural Engineering respectively.

### PROF. ASIMIYU MOHAMMED JINADU

orn on January 3, 1965 in Kisi, Oyo State, Prof. Jinadu obtained his B.Sc. degree in Geography with Second Class Upper Division and Masters degree in Urban and Regional Planning from University of Ibadan in 1991 and 1995 respectively. He had his Ph.D degree in Remote Sensing Application from Federal University of Technology, Minna in 2004.

He started his work experience as Research Assistant YOBA Associate under the Centre for Urban and Regional Planning University Ibadan. He later became Program Officer, African

Centre for Environment Development Information Network (ACEDIN), Ibadan between January and August 1996. He was at Federal Polytechnic, Bida from 1996 to 1998 as Lecturer III from where he took up appointment with Federal University of Technology, Minna as Lecturer II with the Department of Urban and Regional Planning in 1999. He rose through the ranks to become Professor of Urban and Regional Planning effective from 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2011.

Prof. Jinadu has served the University in different capacities. He was Deputy Director, Centre for Human Settlements and Urban Development from 2008 to 2010 and currently, the Director, Centre for Disaster Risk Management and Development Studies.

The Don who belongs to several Professional bodies such as Nigerian Institute of Town Planners (MNITP), Registered Town Planner (RTP), Association of Nigerian Geographer (ANG) and member, Man O'war Statesman Council, University of Ibadan is widely published in books, learned journals and has attended many local and international conferences. Austria from 1984 to 1985 for a Certificate in German Language Proficiency and in 1989 obtained a Diploma in Computer Data-Techniques at the Institute of Computer Science, Technical University of Vienna, Austria. In 2002 she obtained her Ph.D degree in Agricultural Engineering specializing in *Food Processing and Storage* from Federal University of Technology, Minna.

In 1990 Prof. (Mrs.) Osunde joined the services of Federal University of Technology, Minna as Lecturer II in the Department of Agricultural Engineering where she steadily rose through the ranks and became a Professor of Agricultural Engineering with effect from 1st October, 2011.

She has supervised many undergraduate, Master as well as Ph.D research thesis. The Don has held many administrative positions among which are,

Vice-Chairperson, Nigerian Society of Engineers (NSE), 2006 to 2009, Head of Department, Agricultural Engineering, FUT, Minna 2006 to 2008, CEFE Coordinator, Federal University of Technology, Minna 2011 to date and presently Chairperson, Association of Professional Women Engineers (APWEN), Minna branch.
