- Select Project Payment that will lead to description of payment
- Then you type the purpose of payment
- Indicate the amount you are paying to Federal University of Technology, Minna
- Then write your name as Payer. Remember to put your phone number, email address or Matric No.
- You then key in some characters to be displayed
- Click on: "proceed to payment" which will take you to a page where R.R.R. number will be shown.
- Copy the number and go to a bank for payment or pay through other electronic means.
- Please print the transaction receipt for Federal University of Technology, Minna as evidence of payment.

vi. Graduands must be physically present at the ceremony to receive their certificates and prizes as the case may be.

vii. Graduands are expected to fulfill the following conditions to enable them collect their certificates on the spot:

- The original statement of results earlier issued to them by the University (if applicable)
 - Final year clearance form duly signed by all concerned
 - Final year identity card or letter of identification from Student Affairs Division
- viii. The above listed items (a-c) need to be processed not later than two days to the date of the occasion.

ix. Issued Academic Gowns must be returned to the Academic Office through the School Secretaries immediately after the ceremony before the collection of original certificates.

x. There will be a surcharge for any damaged Academic Gown and a charge of N2,000.00 per day for any delayed return of the gown.

xi. There is provision for purchase of academic gown after Convocation; interested students are to liaise with the Academic Office.

Note:

No form of luggage or handbags will be allowed at the convocation venue. Graduands and guests are advised, without exception, to comply with this directive.

No one, including the graduands and their relations will be admitted into the Convocation Square after 9:30 a.m.

Graduands are not allowed to leave the Convocation venue before the end of the ceremony.

They are strongly advised to comply with these arrangements.

The original certificates of all convocating students will be ready for collection immediately after the occasion.

FUTMINNA HOLDS PRESS BRIEFING AHEAD 26TH CONVOCATION

As part of series of activities lined up for the 34th Founder's Day Celebration and 26th Convocation Ceremony of the Federal University of Technology, Minna, Vice-Chancellor's press briefing was held on Thursday, January 26, 2017 at the University's Senate Chamber.

Briefing newsmen, the Vice-Chancellor of the institution, Prof. Musbau Adewumi Akanji, *FNSBMB, FAS*, stated that on Wednesday, February 1, 2017, the University would

confer degrees and diplomas on 3,734 graduands of the 2015/2016 academic session.

Prof. Akanji said 34 graduands made first class, 790 second class upper degrees, 1,345 second class lower degrees, 549 third class while 70 are graduating with pass degrees.

He added that as obtained in the last three years, original certificates of all the graduands would be issued to them immediately after the ceremony.

The Vice-Chancellor further disclosed that there will be conferment of Honorary Doctorate Degrees on three eminent Nigerians in recognition of their contributions to national development: HRH Alhaji (Dr.) Yahaya Abubakar, CFR, Etsu Nupe and Chairman Niger State Council of Traditional Rulers; HRH Alhaji Abubakar Shehu - Abubakar, Modibbo Abubakar III, Emir of Gombe; Chairman of Gombe State Council of Emirs and Chiefs and Professor Akin Ladipo Mabogunje, a renowned retired Professor of Geography, pioneer Urban and Regional Planner and Chairman, Lagos Megacity Development Authority.

Prof. Akanji disclosed that the University has continued to improve in its performance, both academically and in research output and ranks among the best 100 universities in Africa.

On research, the VC said many researchers won local and international grants from Petroleum Technology Development Fund (PTDF), Nigerian

Communications Commission (NCC), TETFund, University of Mississippi, University of Tulane, German, Ministry of Education and Research and University of the West of England, Bristol. FUT, Minna won 3rd overall best prize in NUC organized research and development trade fair, he added.

Prof. Akanji noted that during the year, the following projects were completed and will be commissioned during the week: the Multi Billion Naira Ultra-Modern Female Hostel, Teaching and Research Farm Complex, Block of Classrooms and Renovated Sports Complex, all constructed under the Special Presidential Needs Assessment Intervention and Electronic Test Centre constructed with funds from Internally Generated Revenue of the University. A new Radio House donated by Dr. Muhammed Badamasi Babangida.

On Collaborations and Linkages, the VC said in order to continue to improve on its service delivery, the University has continued to strengthen its collaboration with other institutions and bodies which he said has in turn yielded dividends in terms of funding and material benefits. These institution include: Exxon Mobil, Nigerian Institute of Welding, National Emergency Management Agency, TRADOC, Nigerian Army, Nigerian Air Force and National Centre for Technology Management. Others are University of Tulane, Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University, University of Mississippi, University of Johannesburg, University of Science and Technology, Windhoek, University of Bournemouth, UK, University of Bonn, German Ministry of Education and Research, Global Risk Forum, Davos.

The VC also disclosed that as one of the University's cardinal duties to foster mutual beneficial relationship with the community, staff and students donated two bus loads of relief materials to the IDP Camps in the Northeast and donation of food and clothing materials to those temporarily displaced in Bosso Local Government Area of Niger State.

The University actively participated in the Annual Trade Fair organised by Niger State Chamber of Commerce, Industries, Mines and Agriculture and Nigerian Air Force. Prof. Akanji said that FUT, Minna is in the forefront in Nigeria in the delivery of inaugural lectures by professors with 5 public lectures delivered last year including that of Her Excellency, Dr. Amina Abubakar Bello.

The Vice-Chancellor also disclosed that the University will continue to invest in the training of its manpower by sponsorship of staff to institutions both locally and internationally to acquire further qualifications and for conferences and seminars.

EMIR SANUSI FLAGS OFF FUTMINNA MULTI-MILLION NAIRA MOSQUE

Emir of Kano, HRH. Mallam Muhammadu Sanusi II, CON, today flagged-off the multi-million naira new Central Mosque of the Main Campus, Federal University of Technology, Minna. He was accompanied by the Emir of Minna, HRH Umar Farouk Bahago.

After the official opening of the Mosque, Emir Sanusi led the two rakaah Juma'at special prayer to mark the 34th Founder's Day and 26th Convocation ceremony of the University.

In his sermon, he emphasized the importance of a Mosque to the Muslim community, stressing that it is where Allah is remembered and souls are purified and whoever builds a mosque will be rewarded by Allah.

The Emir enjoined the Muslim Ummah to always keep the

mosque clean, just as he reminded them of the etiquette of using the place of worship.

In his address, the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Musbau Adewumi Akanji, **FNSBMB, FAS**, recalled that the edifice, which cost about N110 million was funded through contributions from Muslim staff of the University, with each of them contribution two and a half percent of their salary over a 3-year period.

Prof Akanji also appreciated other Muslims who are not staff of the institution but contributed to the project both in cash and material.

He disclosed that the design of the Mosque included a library, Islamic Study Centre, Imam's Residence and a conference hall and solicited for support towards actualizing the other components.

The VC expressed appreciation to the Emir of Kano for accepting to commission the project and lead the congregational prayers. He also thanked the Emir of Minna for his immeasurable support.

Dignitaries at the event included Alh. Tanko Ahmed, Special Adviser, Religious Affairs, who represented Niger State of Governor; Pro-Chancellor and Chairman of the University's Governing Council, Prof. Rufa'i Ahmed Alkali; DVC (Admin) Prof. Suleiman Sadiku; Sheikh Ahmed Lemu; Provost of the Niger State College of Education, Prof. Haruna Rasheed, former Vice-Chancellors of the University, Profs. Muhammad Daniyan and Muhammed Salihu Audu; former DVC (Admin), Prof. Muhammed Suleiman; former DVC (Academic), Prof. Abdullahi Bala and former Registrar, Mallam Muhammad Dattijo Usman among many others.

TURNITIN TRAINING/ACADEMIC INTEGRITY WORKSHOP HOLDS IN FUTMINNA

The Federal University of Technology, Minna has hosted the 9th Turnitin Training/Academic Integrity Workshop. The training which took place on Monday, January 16, 2017 at the School of Engineering and Engineering Technology Auditorium was in collaboration with Oracle TSL, the custodians of Turnitin Nigeria.

The Vice-Chancellor of the institution, Prof. Musbau Adewumi Akanji, *FNSBMB, FAS*, who was represented by the

Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Administration), Prof. Suleiman Sadiku said Turnitin is one of the greatest thing to happen to Nigerian Universities, he said that in the past, promotion in the academia was based on having spent a particular number of years in a position but these was changed before you become a professor, you ought to have been well published and in the process a lot of academicians began to plagiarise other peoples publication.

Prof. Akanji explained that this turn of events brought about the turnitin software which could identify if a particular publication was plagiarised a copied work which was done by somebody else and to also restore academic integrity in the universities.

The led resources person at the workshop was Prof. Oluwole Morenikeji, the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic), who is a Turnitin Awardee for Global Innovation and Academic Integrity. He also led and pushed for anti-plagiarism policies to be implemented across all departments of the University and other academic centres in Nigeria .

He spearheaded the use of turnitin in FUT, Minna while other universities followed suit, and represented the University at the recipient entity for the 2014 Academic Integrity Award for Middle East and Africa, an award meant to recognise individual and institutional efforts and hard work put into academic integrity projects.

Other speakers at the workshop include Iyk Ekwelibe,

Manager, Technical Operations Oraco TSL and Turnitin Lead, Nigeria who spoke on plagiarism Grading and Similarity Index; Mr. Princewill Odum who was the winner of 2016 Turnitin Global Innovation Award and also the winner, 2016 Academic Integrity Award for Africa and the Middle East.

An award was presented to the Vice-Chancellor of the University for being the first Nigeria University to initiate a study on anti plagiarism, the first Nigeria University to put forward a sustainability model for the implementation of an anti-plagiarism solution and also for having the highest number of Turnitin student-users in Nigerian institutions which is over 10,000 users. The award was received by Prof. Sadiku on behalf of the Vice-Chancellor.
