EX-BASKETBALLER AKIGA, DONATES TOWARDS SPORTS DEVELOPMENT IN FUTMINNA

The CEO/Chairman, Choice Leisure Ltd, Chief Felix Akiga (JP) has extended his Philanthropist gesture to the Federal University Technology, Minna by donating some sports items.

Presenting the items to the University on Tuesday, October 9, 2018 at the Vice-Chancellor's Office, Main Campus, the retired professional basketballer said the donation is to enhance students participation in sporting activities and also his way of giving back to sports for making him who he is today.

Chief Akiga gave a detailed run down of how his basketball skills earned him admission to US where he became professional basketball player and later moved to Europe where he retired.

Explaining further, he said through his academy and donations, he was able to produce a couple of professional basketball players, including former captain of the Nigerian Basketball team, Olumide Oyedeji and charged the University to organise students' inter-faculty or inter-departmental basketball tournament. He promised to give the winning teams (male and female) the sum of N50,000.00 (Fifty Thousand Naira) each.

The Philanthropist, while commending the institution for its interest in sporting activities, disclosed that he is a consultant to TETFund and currently working with NEEDs Assessment Funds to improve sporting and recreational facilities in higher institutions. "My company is into tourism and they have worked with some universities to improve their recreational facilities," he reiterated.

Responding, the Vice-Chancellor of the University Prof. Abdullahi Bala, *fsssn*, thanked Chief Akiga for the donations. He assured him that the University takes sports seriously and that is why every Wednesday, as

from 2pm upward is lecture free and dedicated to sporting activities. He disclosed that last year, the University introduced inter-faculty football competition and that with the trophies donated by Chief Akiga, it would now introduce an inter-faculty basketball competition.

Noting that the University's contingent just returned from the inter-university staff games held at University of Ilorin, Kwara State, said the donations will go a long way in encouraging staff and students to participate in sports.

The items donated were two trophies, two footballs, two handballs, two basketballs and two volleyballs.

Speaking during the ceremony, the Vice-Chancellor of

the institution, Prof. Abdullahi Bala, *fsssn*, congratulated and thanked the students for their conduct during the election, adding that the electoral committee has been diligent, not showing any biased throughout the electioneering.

Prof. Bala noted that the SUG is an important arm of the student community and that is why the leadership must be seen to be credible, a reason why Management is always concerned about ensuring transparency in their elections.

The VC assured the new Student leaders of the Management effort in addressing some of the challenges faced by students, saying there must be a sense of responsibility in whatever they do. "Where there is peace and co-operation, progress will surely happen," he reiterated.

The new President of the SUG, Fatoye Ayodeji Matthew of the Department of Crop Production pledged that they will work together because they are going to run an inclusive administration, adding that the new executives will ensure that the strategic objectives of student unionism are met in all ramifications as the union exists to serve the students .

He said, the Union Executive Council is not just to serve as a bridge between the Management and students alone, but also to do what they can in moving the University to greater heights global reckoning in line with her vision and mission statement.

NUSSA GAMES 2018: TEAM FUTMINNA WINS 3 GOLD MEDALS

The Federal University of Technology, Minna rounded off the 13th edition of the Nigerian Universities Staff Sports Association (NUSSA) Games in emphatic fashion with three gold, nine silver and five bronze medals to record its best ever performance in the game's history.

The winning streak for the University started at the Ilorin Golf Club when Patrick Pius of the Students Affairs Division claimed the institution's first gold medal in golf, winning 80-22 gross points against Bayero University, Kano in the Handicap category to signal the University's intention to make a mark at the event.

Mr. Saidu Musa Bala, also of the

Students Affairs Division, won another gold medal in golf for the University in the Handicap 80 category, while Dr. Rasheed Ojutiku, the Chairman, University Sports Committee and Bakare Oye of the Physical Planning and Development Unit (PPDU) clinched a silver and bronze medal respectively.

In the female category of the Chess competition, Nwankwo Franka Chinenye, Department of Industrial and Technology Education won a gold medal to clinch the institution's first medal by a female athlete in the games, while Nkechi Nwakife, Department of Chemistry, won silver medals in two different boards.

The University's athletes also dominated the Chess event by winning three bronze and two silver medals in the male and female categories. Segun Saliu of the Information and Technology Services (ITS) finished third behind University of Jos and University of Nigeria, Nsukka in the keenly-contested game to record the institution's first medal in chess at the games.

This performance was followed up by two subsequent bronze medals won by Ibrahim Wali of the Department of Water Resources, Aquaculture and Fisheries Technology (WRAFT) who lost the Board 2 game to the University of Benin, while Alor Emmanuel, Department of Chemical Engineering won the third bronze medal for the institution.

In Scrabble, Maruf Kunle of the Registry Department

narrowly lost to University of Ilorin in the male category final played inside the Multi-Purpose Hall to clinch a silver medal for the University.

The University's superlative performance at the NUSSA Games continued on day five with Lawrence Umogbai of the Students Affairs Division winning two silver medals for the University in Dart Men 501 and TDB singles. In the men's doubles, Lawrence Umogbai and James Nwankpa (PPDU) also won a bronze medal to increase the University's medal haul at the games.

In Squash, Dr. Rasheed Ojutiku and Dr. Ladi Bello of the Department of Crop Production won a silver medal in men's doubles, while Abdullahi Usman of the Department of Statistics and Felix Seriki of the University Security Services lost the Badminton final to Ahmadu Bello University, Zaria who featured Nigeria's best badminton player.

In the female category of the Javelin event, Umore Unelati of the Bursary Department won a silver medal to record the University's only medal in the track and field event.

Appraising the University contingent's performance at the Games, Dr. Ojutiku commended the athletes for making the institution proud, adding that the number of medals won by the University at the biennial event has shown that FUT, Minna was no longer a pushover in sports in the comity of universities in the country.

The Chairman attributed the success recorded by the University at the Games to the support extended to the contingent by the University Management. He applauded the Vice-Chancellor of the institution, Prof. Abdullahi Bala, *fsssn*, for being a sports-friendly administrator.

The 10-day tournament, which took place at the University of Ilorin, saw over 60 universities-federal, state and private-jostling for medals in 15 different sports.
